

Early Conditional Offer Terms & Conditions

Eligibility for an early conditional offer at Curtin University:

Current Year 12 students, interstate Year 12 students and IB Diploma students are eligible to apply for an early conditional offer for selected undergraduate courses at Curtin

To be considered for an early conditional offer at Curtin University, you are required to meet the following conditions:

- Submit an application through TISC, and list the preferred Curtin course¹ as your first preference and maintain this first preference until the TISC December offer round is released. If your interstate Year 12 or IB Diploma result will be released after the TISC December offer round, you are required to maintain this first course preference until the TISC January offer round;
- Complete the [early offer online form](#) by 30 September 2019; and
- Be on track to meet the course requirements².

Important notes:

1. Only applicable for courses that are available for early conditional offers. Please refer to the early offer web page for the list of excluded courses.

2. These requirements may include any or all of the following:

- I. Achieve WACE (for WACE students only);
- II. Achieve the ATAR required for the course applied³, or complete an AQF Certificate IV at a recognised training provider;
- III. Meet Curtin University's English language proficiency⁴ by being currently enrolled in one of Curtin University's accepted English ATAR courses, Interstate Year 12 English courses or IB English courses; and
- IV. Satisfy any course prerequisites and any other course requirements⁴.

4. Curtin University's English language proficiency criteria:

- I. WACE students require a scaled score of 50 in English ATAR, Literature ATAR, or English as an additional language/dialect ATAR.

After receiving the early conditional offer:

5. Please note offer conditions will be assessed once your WACE/IB Diploma results are available through TISC. You are not required to provide evidence of your ATAR/IB results to Curtin University.

6. If you have received more than one early conditional offer from Curtin University, only the most recent will be valid and any previous early conditional offers will be superseded.

7. If you change your mind and remove the early offered course as your first preference in your TISC application before the TISC December offer round, your early conditional offer will be invalid.

8. If your ATAR/IB results do not meet the required ATAR or subject prerequisites for the course offered in your Early Offer, you may still receive an offer for a lower preference in the December offer round. As all Curtin course preferences will be assessed you may also consider changing your TISC course preferences to include Curtin pathway course(s) by the required TISC deadline.
